Minutes of Annual General Meeting 11th November 2014 The Exmouth Arms Bath road 19.30 hours

27 members attended

Apologies for absence: None received

Appointment of Tellers: The members present agreed to an open vote, with show of hands. Steve Smith to count.

Minutes of the 2013 AGM. Members were asked to confirm that the minutes of last year's AGM were a true record of the proceedings. The minutes were accepted unanimously.

Matters arising from the 2013 minutes. No comments received.

Chairman's Report and Other Officer's Reports - All Reports were printed in full, and available at the meeting. The Chairman gave a brief resume of the past year, giving due regard to our achievements and an indication of future direction for the club. The Chairman also reminded members that participation by members is vital for the longevity of our club.

Road Report - This was read out, again stressing the need for active participation by members. Summarised very succinctly by **"Ask not what your club can do for you, But ask what you can do for your club"**

Annual Accounts for the Year ending 31st October 2014. The Treasurer gave a brief overview of 2014 accounts. Reporting the overall balance as approximately £23300.

Members were then asked to approve the accounts. Proposed by Tom Lejeune seconded by Mike Wake. Unanimous acceptance. Note an audit of the opening and closing stock of Club clothing to be included for future accounts.

Increase in Subs The proposed new subs Senior £25. Over 65 £15. Junior £15. Youth u/16 £10. Family £40. Event helpers are to be given a £5 credit against renewal, for the next year, for every event they volunteer for. Subject to a maximum not to exceed the appropriate membership fee for that class of member. Proposed Rachael Dale seconded Charlie Williams. (23 for 2 against) Accepted

Election of Officers of the Club.

- **Chairman:** Pat Alexander was co-opted as temporary chair during the year, (following resignation by Tim Sluman). Pat resigned. John Hawes proposed by Doug Gale seconded by Steve Smith. Elected unanimously. a vote of thanks was then proposed by Martin McGreary, for Pats excellent work during this year, endorsed by all present.
- **General Secretary:** Doug Gale (elected 2010). Re-elected.
- **Treasurer:** Martin McGreary (elected 2005). Re-elected.
- **Membership Secretary:** Stuart Trigg (elected 2012) not present, the committee has had no indication if Stuart wishes to continue with this role. Robin Mainwaring has offered to take over this role. Mike Wake asked if Membership cards are to be re-established?

- o **Communications Manager:** Gary Rickards resigned last year. The role is now integrated with Web Masters: Rob Haynes has agreed to continue with web maintenance. Only required to attend committee meetings when requested.

 - o Ladies: Louise Bish seconded during 2013 resigned proposed Emma Trueman. Elected.
 - o Social Secretary Rachael Dale seconded during the year. Re-elected.
